Unless we are a money-making machine, we cannot secure cultural heritage. He said that we have to come forward to preserve cultural heritage.

We are responsible for natural disasters only

Bharat Raj Singh, president of The Institution of Engineers India said that freedom of expression does not mean that we become autocratic. He said that in ancient times only we were not given education in Gurukul. Rather we were also fully developed. He said that we have become professional. It seems as if we have become old age homes. He said that we are only

responsible for natural calamities. He said that in our cultural heritage there is the power to add everyone; the world has the power to take forward, so we need protection.



Cultural heritage does not mean limited to monument protection

Saurabh Mishra, secretary of the Unite Foundation, said that cultural heritage is not restricted to temple or memorial conservation. This includes the protection of art, folklore etc. Unite's resolve is to take all the people together. It is our resolve to carry forward with any person who is involved in any good work other than daily work.

During the program BC Little of Lucknow University, University of Arts informed me that my main work is photography and graphics designing. A photo equals one thousand words. It means to say that if you want to put any condition in front of someone with 1000 words, then only one picture is sufficient for that. That photo is enough to talk about all those situations.

Dean of Maharishi Technology Technical University Prof.Hk Dwivedi said that culture is like a teacher who helps us move forward. Our trustees help us to go to the truth. He said that we need to preserve the heritage.

Director General of National Cultural Property Protection Research Bureau BV Kharbad said that culture and heritage are our heritage. He said archives, museums, ancient buildings are our heritage.
